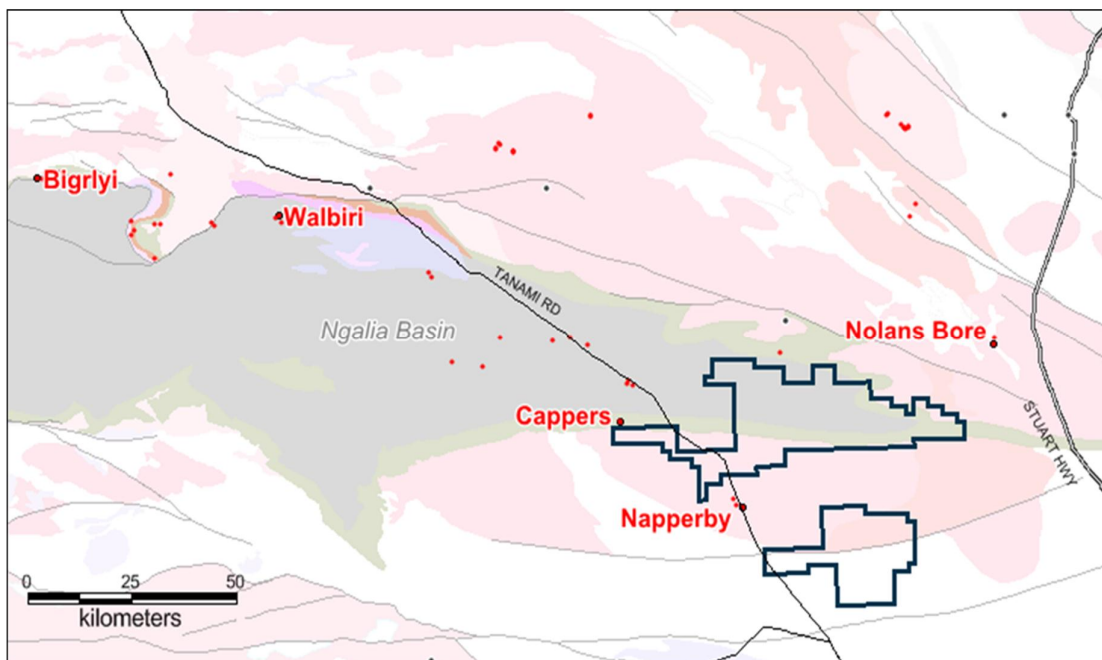


Eclipse Project

Rockland Resources are pleased to announce the granting of an Exploration License (EL) consisting of approximately 485 km² with a second application grant imminent. The Eclipse project is located 115 km north west of Alice Springs, NT.



The project is adjacent to exploration licences held by Deep Yellow, which contain the Napperby uranium deposit 5 km to the south and 10 km to the north west of Rockland Resources tenements. The Napperby deposit is hosted by shallow paleochannel calcretes with a JORC- compliant Inferred Resource of 9.34 Mt @ 359 ppm U₃O₈ for 7.39 Mlbs U₃O₈.

In addition, the Nolan's Bore deposit is located 20 km northeast and also contains uranium of secondary economic significance to rare earth elements (REEs) and phosphate mineralisation hosted within the Arunta Block.

Within the Ngalia basin are a number of advanced uranium prospects and deposits including the Bigryli Deposit with a resource of 20.6 Mlb of U₃O₈ and 38.6 Mlb of V₂O₅.

The Patty Well iron ore (gold) occurrence is within the Eclipse project.
